

UHWO Writing Intensive (WI) Policies

- None of Leeward CC Writing Intensive (WI) courses transfer to UHWO as fulfilling any of their WI requirements.
- This is because UHWO requires 3 WI classes, all upper division.

- This is different than the UHM which requires their Baccalaureate graduates to have taken 5 WI classes (at least 2 of which must be at the 300 level or above).

- Because of the "Reverse AA degree" program, students at UHWO can earn a Leeward AA degree and never have taken any lower level WI courses.
- "Reverse AA Degree program": Students from the UH community colleges, who have transferred to one of the 4-year UH campuses without their AA degree will receive one when they have earned enough credits while at the 4-year college.
