The following course proposal was received by a subgroup and passed at the full Curriculum Committee meeting on 2/19/08. We ask that the Faculty Senate accept our recommendations for the following:

AG 112 Intro to Organic Agriculture (3 credits) New

From Proposal:

There are at least 10 students per year who are working at Ma'o Farm in Waianae who will take this course as part of the AA degree with Community Food Security Emphasis. In addition, the course will be taken by other students and community members who are motivated by the increasing awareness worldwide of the importance of sustainable agriculture.

This course is required for the approved Academic Subject Certificate in Community Food Security. This course will not lengthen the time to complete an AA degree and will not replace any other course. This course (AG 112) has been taught for two years at LCC as the experimental course AG 197 and it will take the place of AG 197 if approved.
