2017 – 2018 Curriculum Committee Report

Major Accomplishments:

Required the correct use of the Prerequisite gadget (field 3.1) for courses in KSCM. Also, required the use of the Program Rules gadget (field 3.4) for programs. We required these two fields to take advantage of being able to do dependency analysis on courses and programs. Below is an example of ICS 110P and you are able to tell what program(s) these courses are part of due to the use of these gadgets.
