96-1	9/6/95	<p>To accept the Senate Chair's Proposal to support, as a scheduling option, the offering of up to twelve double-sized classes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION R96-1</p> <p>The Leeward Community Senate endorses, on a trial basis, the Senate Chairs Proposal to support as a scheduling option the offering of up to twelve double sized classes for the upcoming Spring 1996 semester.</p> <p>We recommend the use of this scheduling strategy only for high demand courses suitable for lecture style delivery, such as History 151, History 152, Oceanography 201, Art 101, Astronomy 110, and other courses as determined by the Discipline Coordinators in cooperation with the Division.</p> <p>We recommend that the schedule of courses clearly identify such courses as large, lecture-style courses.</p> <p>We recommend that all faculty teaching such classes be volunteers and tenured.</p> <p>recommend that the teaching load of each of the participating instructors be four sections, two of which will be double sized. The instructor will also hold their normal five office hours.</p> <p>We recommend that participating instructors obtain student evaluations for the double sized classes and report to the Senate on their evaluation of the experience for themselves and their students and their subject.</p> <p>Further, we recommend that the approval of the 96-97 Senate be obtained prior to continuing this program beyond the Spring semester of 1996.</p>	17-1-1	Student Government opposed the policy.
