On 4/4/18, the General Education Committee met and voted to accept Leeward CC's General Education designations as acceptable to satisfy the WICHE Passport learning outcomes they most closely resemble. The General Education Committee voted not to accept Focus designations (e.g., ETH, HAP, WI) to satisfy the WICHE Passport learning outcomes.

On 5/1/18 the majority of the members of the General Education Committee voted to approve the following points regarding the WICHE Passport:

1. IP is only for students who transfer to a WICHE IP partner outside of Hawai'i. (This removes the major obstacle about the impact intrastate transfers might have on the AA degree.)
2. Student must have at least 7 Leeward Community College credits. (Requested by counseling so it conforms with other certificates.)
3. All courses that meet a learning outcome must have a minimum grade of C. (Requested by counseling so it conforms with other certificates.)
4. Critical Thinking and Team Work and Value System have no Leeward Community College designation to align with - as these are cross-cutting skills that take place in many different areas. (This allows OC, Foundations and Diversification courses to be used in a dual or multi-purpose manner to meet these requirements. This is sometimes called double dipping. Without this the IP is almost impossible to obtain.)
