

## **Resolutions from 12/6/19 Faculty Senate Meeting**

### ***Leeward Community College Faculty Senate Resolution 19.1 - Resolution in Support of Amending the Leeward Community College Facilities Use Procedures and Processes***

Whereas the academic use of campus facilities promotes students' success and supports the College's and University of Hawai'i (UH) System's educational missions;

Whereas faculty, staff, and students have repeatedly encountered difficulties reserving campus rooms and facilities in an effort to promote said educational goals;

Whereas problems associated with "facilities use procedures and processes" have been communicated to administration by the faculty;

Whereas problems associated with the "facilities use procedures and processes" have gone unresolved;

Whereas new policy governing the direction of "facilities use procedures and processes" was recently shared in the Campus Council for the recommendation of approval by the Chancellor without recognition for Shared Governance and the following proper campus procedures on policy development and review, including consultation from the Faculty Senate;

Be it resolved that the Leeward Community College Faculty Senate deems the current "facilities use procedures and processes" both inefficient and ineffective, and strongly endorses administrative action in amending it. We request that these amendments to the "facilities use procedures and processes" be driven by the results of a Spring 2020 campus survey on the "facilities use procedures and processes" and that the administration is required to act.
