

## Faculty Senate: Legislative Relations Committee Report

December 06, 2019

The Legislative Relations Committee received this notice on Thursday, Dec. 5, 2019 at 3:16 p.m. and felt that this was important enough to submit even at the last minute. What is absent from the listed “topics” is salary raises for UH Faculty. According to UHPA (9/2019), “ 1.2% raise Jan 1, 2020 was not approved In UHPA’s analysis, the roadblock is Governor Ige. In negotiations, the State wanted concessions for the raise, UHPA rejected.”

If faculty raises do not make it to the Spring 2020 session, faculty must wait for another calendar year for this to be taken up again in the Spring 2021 session.
