

MAUI 2018 Repeat Policy

Students may repeat any UH Maui College course once without consent. The third or any subsequent attempt of the same course requires approval of the program coordinator, discipline coordinator, or department chair for the course.

This policy does not apply to:

1. Courses which are identified in the UH Maui College Catalog as repeatable for additional credit. These courses may be repeated up to the maximum number specified.
2. Allied Health students. Students applying to the Allied Health program must adhere to the Allied Health repeat policy.

To be eligible as an attempted repeat, the subsequent attempted course must have the equivalent number of credits.

The credit from a repeated course is entered once toward the credit earned and applied only once toward a certificate or degree requirement, unless specified otherwise in the course description.

All grades are reflected on the transcript, but only the highest grade is computed into the grade point average.

Students who intend to transfer are reminded that many colleges and universities do not permit the substitution of the most recent grades when computing grade point ratios and will compute the grade point ratio according to their own standards.

For financial aid purposes, students should refer to UHMC's Financial Aid Office repeat policy.

Definitions

repeated course: A repeated course is a course that a student enrolls in and attempts more than once.

attempted course: A course with an A, B, C, D, F, CR, or I grade will count as an attempted course.
