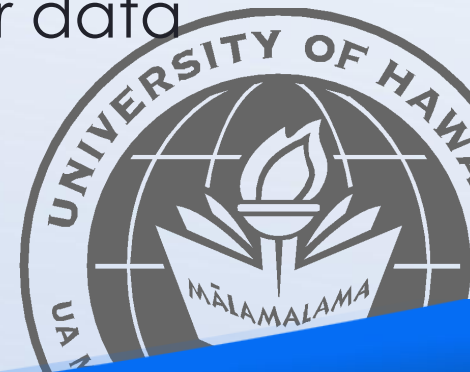

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Value of CES

- Students able to provide feedback on their learning for all their courses.
- Faculty can receive useful feedback on their teaching practices & have an additional tool to demonstrate teaching effectiveness.
- Deans, directors or chairs can get another data point regarding curriculum & program effectiveness.



Similarities

- Faculty can copy surveys between semesters & years.
- Faculty can publish surveys to website.
- Aggregate means for common questions available on results.
- Results downloadable in PDF & Excel formats.
- Results archived.
- Results available for use by faculty as part of their T&P documentation.



Difference from eCAFE

- Campuses, divisions, departments can determine questions sets for courses at various levels.
- 100%* of credit courses will be assessed.
- Mobile and web access.
- ADA compliant.
- Results shared with department/division chair.
- Aggregate results of common questions will be shared according to campus guidelines.
- Faculty section:
 - Ability to add own questions
 - Ability to curate questions
 - Aggregation among sections
