Memory	2 GB

Mouse	Optical Mouse
Keyboard	USB Keyboard
Display	19 inch LCD

This is the minimum PC and Macintosh hardware recommended for campus workstations. Computer systems that meet or exceed this recommendation will run the current campus supported software. The campus supported software consists of the current version of the operating system, office suite, Internet browsers and email client software. The campus recommended hardware is derived using this is multi-step process.

1. For each item from the Campus Supported Software list, we review the published system requirements.
2. This information is collected and reviewed by the IT staff to determine a level of computer hardware that can adequately run all the software.
3. This level of hardware is identified as the "Minimum PC/Macintosh Hardware".

The importance of this Minimum Hardware Platform is that it can be used as a gauge to determine the adequacy of hardware for yourself or your unit. This

information is reviewed by the Information Technology Group on an annual basis and revised as needed.

It is important to note that there are many faculty and staff that have higher hardware requirements. The level of hardware is the minimum standard for any equipment that would be deployed on our campus by the Information Technology Group. Hardware falling below this level would typically be salvaged for parts and disposed.
